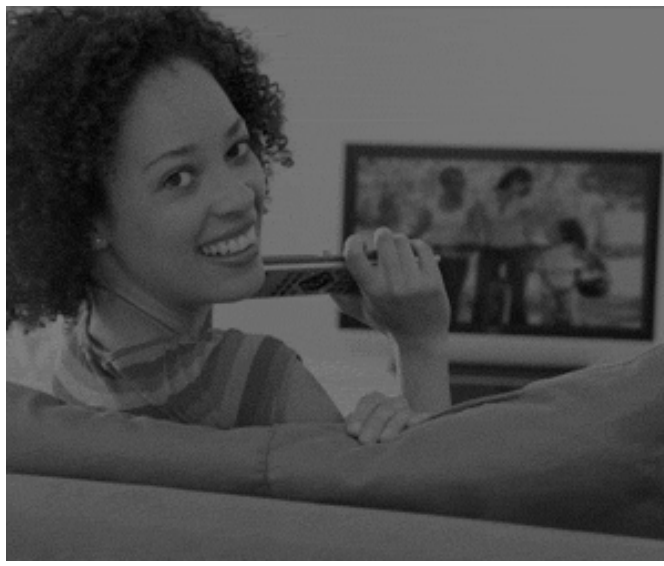
The public is invited to attend and watch Johnson on top of the truck.
