

Boss surprises staffers/volunteers with Badgers' national championship game tickets

MADISON (WKOW) -- More than a dozen employees and volunteers at the Boys and Girls Club of Dane County are singing the praises of their boss tonight.

CEO Michael Johnson surprised staffers midway through Monday morning by announcing he got tickets for 18 people to go to the Wisconsin Badgers NCAA National Championship game versus Duke in Indianapolis.
